Rehoboth Town Council urge all its customers with arrears on their accounts to please visit the Finance Department Credit Controllers to renew payment arrangements on their accounts to avoid disconnection.

The conversion to the Munsoft Financial system does not recognise arrangements made previously therefore all customers who made prior arrangements on the arrear accounts are encouraged to contact the Finance Department to avoid being listed for disconnection of water and electricity services.

Let us help you plan to pay off your historical debt over a short period of time, using the flexible repayment options available to avoid disconnection of services.

Please take note if no arrangements are recognised on the system, or no payments received, than the system automatically add your name to the disconnection list, hence services will be disconnected without notification.



PRIVATE BAG 2500 REHOBOTH

Tenants on Rehoboth Town lands to keep their livestock within the boundaries of the camps, as animal grazing along the main roads can cause great danger to road users as it cause motor vehicle accidents, injuries and in some cases, it may cause loss of lives.

Tenants are reminded to comply with Clause No. 17 of the lease agreement that stipulate that: "No Lessee shall at any time allow any of his/her animals to run at large beyond the allocated camp".

Take note of the following conditions:


- Should any animal be found roaming at large, such animal will be impounded and the Lessee shall be liable for the cost of impounding such animal.
- Further, any accident or injuries that occur to third party as a result of such animal running at large, the Lessee with be held liable of such claims.
- On breach of any of the conditions or provisions of this agreement by the Lessee, the Lessor shall have the right to cancel this agreement immediately and the Lessee undertakes to compensate the Lessor with any damages or costs, which may arise as a result of such breach of agreement.
- Upon further violation of this clause, Rehoboth Town Council will record the stock brand numbers for such animal and will terminate the contracts with immediate effect and remove such tenant from the camp.
